When?

Sunday, August 13 to Friday, August 18, 2023

We will leave early on the 13th and arrive back in the evening of the 18th.

With whom?

We are going with 4 other local churches: Gracepoint, CK Presbyterian, Sylvan Way Baptist, and Family Worship Center. A total of about 300 students will be present!

Who can go?

Any Faith Fellowship youth from those *going into* grade 6 for the 2023-2024 school year to Seniors who have just graduated.

What are we going to do?

The word EPIC is overused, but...it's going to be epic. We'll have oodles of outdoor group games, an indoor gym, archery, frisbee golf, sports tournaments, zip lines, paint ball, climbing walls, crafts, chapel, hiking, swimming, water slides, boating, tubing, wake/knee boarding, and much more!

How much does it cost?

\$399 per person because it is going to be epic. This price includes all transportation, cabin accommodations, most activities, and meals while at camp. Please bring extra money for the Snack Shop and for meals and snacks as we travel there and back. Also, some activities such as paintball come with a cost as you would have to purchase your ammo.



Where am I going to find \$399?

You do not need to. To all students who work their designated Fireworks stand shifts between the days of June 27 and July 4, your cost will only be **\$125!** The remaining \$274 will be covered by the proceeds of the Fireworks stand (\$125 + \$274 = \$399). Yep, only \$125 for four days of epicness! You do not have to participate in the Fireworks stand – you may opt out of that and just pay the \$399.

A few FAQs:

How do I sign up?

1. You may register and pay at www.faithfellowshipchurch.net/ignite-youth/
 - a. There is a required deposit of \$50 that is refundable up until July 23rd.
 - b. If you plan on paying the entire \$399 you may register and pay at any time before July 30th.
 - c. If you plan on working at the Fireworks stand to pay the discounted rate of \$125, then register at any time and pay the \$50 deposit but wait to pay the remaining \$75 until after July 5th but before July 30th.
 - d. All payments have to be made by July 30th.
2. Your parents will have to fill out the AWAKE 2023 SUMMER CAMP LIABILITY RELEASE.
3. If you require medication while at camp, your parents will have to fill out the FAITH FELLOWSHIP MEDICATION AUTHORIZATION.
4. You will have to fill out the ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RULES document.

Cell Phone/Electronics Policy:

This is a “**Disconnect to reconnect**” camp. You may bring a phone, but it will be securely stored in a lock box for the duration of the camp except for one designated evening where you will have 30 minutes to call home and give updates. You may use your phone on the bus to and from the camp.

Cabin Assignments & Activities:

Students will stay in cabins/dorms with a group of 6-12 peers of the same grade and biological sex and their cabin leader(s). You will be housed with your friends from your church.

Meals:

3 meals a day and snacks are provided by the camp kitchen staff. There is a camp store that takes both cash or card so be prepared for that if you plan on visiting the store a few times during the week :-).

Can my friends who do not attend Faith Fellowship come?

Maybe. There are only 20 spots available, and they will be offered first to regular Faith Fellowship Ignite Youth students. All participants must be in high school or middle school.

Emergency Contact:

Students will not have access to their phones while at camp. Parents may contact Pastor Josh at 206-819-3949. The reception can be spotty at camp. The camp office is equipped with a landline in case of emergency: 509-220-9599.

What do I need to pack?

Please bag the following items and LABEL using a SHARPIE PEN on duct tape. Include your student’s name and grade:

- Sleeping bag and pillow (*pillows can be taken on bus on Sunday*)
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Deodorant, Shampoo, Conditioner, and Body wash)
- 2 Towels
- Swimsuit (Church appropriate... no bikinis/no speedos)
- Changes of clothes (for warm days and cool nights)
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Flashlight
- Tennis Shoes
- Sandals or water shoes
- Bible/journal and Pen
- BREAKFAST for bus ride over, if not eating beforehand
- Cash for lunch stops each way, and some cash the camp snack shack
- Phone charger (for the last night to charge phones prior to bus ride home)

- **Optional:**

- Watch (you will not have your phone to look at the clock)
- Cash and Clothes for paintball

● *You should know your color team by now so bring a few clothing items, headbands, etc. to support your color team if you'd like to earn team points*

- **Optional for staff:**

- **Alarm Clock:** It helps wake students up while we are in our AM meeting and is a way for them to tell time in room.
- **Spray on deodorant:** kids always forget, and this is an easy way that multiple kids can use.
- **Extra body wash & shampoo**
- **Extension cord/ power strip:** for when students need to charge phone on last night; there isn't usually enough spots to plug in
- **For female staff: tampons and/or pads**

DO NOT bring the following items:

- No Face Paint or Colored Hairspray of any kind
- Any weapon (including pocketknives)
- Anything that produces a flame.
- Energy drinks or snacks to store in cabins.
- Laptops or large gaming devices (phones and handheld gaming devices may be used on the bus)
- Drugs, alcohol, or any tobacco-type products (DUH!) ...
